### ENSURING FIRST NATIONS CHILDREN HAVE ACCESS TO THE SERVICES THEY NEED

Jordan's Principle helps to ensure that all First Nations children living on and off reserve have access to the same supports and services as other children and that these are provided without delay. It supports substantive equality for First Nations children when accessing government services, including education, mental health, medical equipment, speech therapy, and more.

Service coordinators are available across Canada to ensure children have access to the services they need. They are a local contact to help children and families get started.
